## **SHAFTESBURY BARNET HARRIERS** ANNUAL REPORT 1 OCTOBER 2012 TO 30 SEPTEMBER 2013

This report provides some of the highlights achieved by our athletes during the last year. But it's not just our top athletes and teams that make us the best overall club in the country, it's all our members, supporters, officials, coaches and others such as parents that make our club great.

The year kicked off with our Women's team of **RACHEL FELTON**, **BETH POTTER**, **VICTORIA WALKER** and **AMY CAMPBELL** winning the Bronze Medal in the National Women's Road Relays.

At the National Cross Country Relays our Under 20 Men's team of **MICHAEL CALLEGARI**, **FRANK BAILEY** and **RICHARD HORTON** became National Champions with the Senior Women's team of **VICTORIA WEBSTER**, **AMY CAMPBELL** and **BETH POTTER** coming second.

**MELISSA COURTNEY** and **ROBERT LIGHTOWLER** won the Junior and Youth World Titles respectively, at World Biathle Championship.

In Athletics Weekly we had two Athletes who featured in the readers' poll for 'Athletes of the Year 2012'. **YAMILLE ALDAMA** and **ANTHONY WHITEMAN** were 2nd and 3rd respectively in the British Veterans section.

BETH POTTER won a team Silver Medal at the European Cross Country Championships.

Also at the Hertfordshire Championship the Under 11 Boys, U13 Boys, Under 17 Men, Under 20 Men and Women took the team titles.

**ALLAN SMITH** set several new Scottish Indoor High Jump records with 2.22 and then 2.23 (both new club records to boot).

At the Southern Indoor Championships **KYLE LANGFORD** U20 took the Silver Medal in the 800m, and **TIM BUCKLE** U20 took the Bronze Medal in the High Jump.

Our Hertfordshire and Middlesex Schools Cross Country Champions were **GERRY O'BRIEN**, **MOLLY PATCH, JAMIE HARPER, ELEANOR HUNT, JAMIE DEE** and **MICHAEL CALLEGARI**, with Silver Medals from **NAOMI KENDALL**, **LIANNE LANGFORD**, **NATALIE CONNOR** and **ROBBIE LIGHTOWLER** and Bronze Medals from **SAM WILSON**, **MARIE SATO**, **NATHAN DAVIES**, **LIAM DEE** and **NATHAN FERNANDES**.

At the British Athletic European Indoor Trials and UK Championships **YAMILE ALDAMA** V40 won the UK Triple Jump Championships, and there were Silver Medals from **ALLAN SMITH** U23 High Jump, **ALLAN SCOTT** 60m Hurdles and **ZANE DUQUEMIN** U23 Shot. There were Bronze Medals from **MELISSA COURTNEY** U23 1500m, **ZOE BROWN** Pole Vault and **DAN BRAMBLE** Long Jump.

There were indoor club records by **MELISSA COURTNEY'S** U23 1500m in 4:17.57 and **DAN BRAMBLE** with 7.80m.

**ANYA RODRIGUEZ** U17 Pole Vault and **DEAN OAMEN** U20 Triple Jump became Eastern/Essex Champions.

**MICHAEL CALLEGARI** U20 won the Bronze Medal in the Southern Cross Country Championships. The team won the Silver Medal with **WILL RYLE-HODGES**, **FRANK BAILEY** and **ASHOK MATHUR**.

Scottish Indoor National Champions were LEE MCCONNELL 200m, GEMMA NICOL 400m, ALLAN SCOTT 60m Hurdles, ALLAN SMITH High Jump and JOHN CARR Triple Jump. ZOE BROWN became the Ireland Indoor Champion in the Pole Vault.

And Bronze Medals came from **KYLE LANGFORD** U20 (800m) and **DEAN OAMEN** (Triple Jump).

At the British Universities Indoor Championship, top honour went to **MELISSA COURTNEY** U23 (Brunel University) who won the Gold Medal in the 1500m. There were also Silver Medals from **ANTONIO INFANTINO** U23 (Kings College London) in the 200m and **ZANE DUQUEMIN** U23 (St Mary's University) in the 7.26kg Shot.

At the European Indoor Championships **YAMILE ALDAMA** V40 finished in 6th place.

British Masters Champions were **ALFREDO MELAO** V55 winning the Long and Triple Jump and **LISA WEBB** V45 who won the 1500m.

**MICHAEL CALLEGARI** represented Great Britain under 20 Men's team in the World Cross Country Championships finishing in 37<sup>th</sup> place.

At the World Indoor Throws Competition there were great throws from **ZANE DUQUEMIN**, **CHRIS SCOTT**, **JADE NICHOLLS** and **AIDAN REYNOLDS** who won the Javelin with 67.56m, which is an all-time British Junior best.

Middlesex and Hertfordshire Indoor Champions were **MOHAMED CHARKAOUI-ESSOUNI** 1500m, **JONAS CHOR** U17 Long Jump, **TARLIA BAILEY** U17 Long Jump and **NNEKA OFULUE** U23 Shot.

There were solid runs in the National and Southern Road Relays. The Men's 12 stage team finishing in 14th position in the National and 5<sup>th</sup> in Southern Championships – these were combined as the Southern was initially cancelled due to snow and ice. Our Women finished in 21st place in the 6 stage race and 10<sup>th</sup> in the Southern Championships.

At the Young Athletes National Relays our Under 13 Boys team of **THOMAS FULTON**, **JAMIE HARPER** and **GEORGE GROOM** won the team Bronze Medals. Also **JAMIE DEE** U15 and **LIAM DEE** U17 won Individual Gold Medals for running the fastest times in their respective races.

At the European Champion Clubs Cup for Seniors in Portugal, we came an excellent 5<sup>th</sup> at our first attempt.

Further new Club records were set – **RICHARD CHARLES** U20 ran the 800m in 1:48.30, **GREGORY THOMPSON** U20 in the 6kg Shot with a distance of 17.75m and then 18.26m, and **NICK PERCY** U20 throwing the 1.75kg Discus 62.21m.

Three Shaftesbury athletes were selected for the GB & NI for the European Team Championship – **ZANE DUQUEMIN** U23 (Shot Putt), **JADE LALLY** (Discus), **YAMILE ALDAMA** V40 (Triple Jump).

At the England Athletics U20/U23 Championships & European Trials there were Gold Medals for ZANE DUQUEMIN U23 (Discus), GREGORY THOMPSON U20 (Shot Putt), SABRINA BAKARE U20 (400m), SEB RODGER U23 (400m Hurdles), NICK PERCY U20 (Discus) and SHADINE DUQUEMIN U20 (Discus) and LOUISA JAMES U20 (Hammer). Silver Medals were won by MELISSA COURTNEY U23 (1500m), ALLAN SMITH U23 (High Jump), SHADINE DUQUEMIN U20 (Shot Putt), BETH POTTER U23 (5000m), GABRIELLA COVENEY U23 (400m Hurdles), GREGOR MACLEAN U23 (Pole Vault), JADE IVE U23 (Pole Vault), DEMPSEY McGUIGAN U23 (Hammer), LOUISA JAMES U23 (Hammer), GREGORY THOMPSON U20 (Discus) and SHADINE DUQUEMIN U23 (Discus). Finally our Bronze Medallists were STEFFI WILSON U20 (100m), MICHAEL CALLEGARI U20 (5000m), AIDAN REYNOLDS U20 (Javelin), RICHARD CHARLES U20 (800m), RACHEL HUNTER U23 (Hammer) and ADAM CARPENTER (Pole Vault).

Following our phenomenal success in the trials **MICHAEL CALLEGARI** (5000m), **NICK PERCY** (Discus), **GREGORY THOMPSON** (Discus), **SHADINE DUQUEMIN** (Discus) and **LOUISA JAMES** (Hammer) **SEB RODGER** (400m Hurdles), **ZANE DUQUEMIN** (Shot and Discus), **RICHARD CHARLES** (800m), **STEFFI WILSON** (4 x 100m Relay) **ALLAN SMITH** (High Jump) and **BETH POTTER** (5000m) were selected to compete in the European age group championships. At the championship **SEB** and **NICK** won Silver and **ALLAN** won Bronze. **STEFFI WILSON** won Gold in the 4 x 100m Relay.

Young Athletes had an excellent day at the Middlesex Schools Championships with Gold Medals from EMMA BABALOLA U15 (100m), SOPHIA PARVIZI-WAYNE U17 (1500m), RACHAEL FATUADE U17 (80m Hurdles) and TAHLIA WELLER-HARRIS U17 (Long Jump). Silver Medals came from KHALID ALI-AHMED U17 (800m), LOLA DOWNES U15 (75m Hurdles) and NABIL HAQUE U15 (Shot Putt). Finally our Bronze Medallists were OLU AROWOJOLU U15 (200m), AURELIJA IPPOLITO U17 (300m), RACHEL CARTER U15 (75m Hurdles) and ALEX CONN U17 (400m Hurdles).

At the Northern Ireland and Ulster Championship **ZOE BROWN** (Pole Vault) and **DEMPSEY MCGUIGAN** U23 (Hammer) won gold medals.

At the Senior and Under 20 Area Championships we had 11 Gold Medallists - **ANTONIO INFANTINO** U23 (200m), **KYLE LANGFORD** U20 (800m), **ZAC RANDALL** U23 (800m), **LIZZIE BIRD** U20 (1500m), **GEMMA BENNETT** (100m Hurdles), **DAN BRAMBLE** (Long Jump), **NONSO OKOLO** (Triple Jump), **CHRIS SCOTT** (Discus 2kg), **DEMPSEY MCGUIGAN** U23 (Hammer 7.26kg), **LOUISA JAMES** U20 (Hammer 4kg) and **NICK PERCY** U20 (Discus 1.75kg with 62.79m) which was a New Club Record.

In the Northern Championships NONY MORDI won the Triple Jump.

In the Welsh U17/U20 Championships in Swansea, MELISSA COURTNEY U23 won the 1500m.

At the World Youth Championship **SABRINA BAKARE** took the 400m Gold Medal and **KYLE LANGFORD** U20 took the Bronze Medal with **LIAM DEE** (1500m) and **FELLAN McGUIGAN** (Hammer) also selected.

SABRINA BAKARE became World Schools Champion in the 400m.

At the Welsh Championship **ZOE BROWN** won the Women's Pole Vault, with **AIDAN REYNOLDS** U20 taking the Silver Medal in the Javelin, and **ADAM CARPENTER** U23 took the Silver Medal in the Men's Pole Vault.

At the Midlands Championships GABRIELLE COVENEY U23 won the 400m Hurdles Gold Medal.

At the Ireland U20/U23 Championships **GABRIELLE COVENEY** U23 who won 400m Hurdles Gold Medal, **DALTON McGUIGAN** U20 won the 3000m Steeplechase Gold Medal and **DEMPSEY McGUIGAN** U23 won the Silver Medal in the Hammer.

**RICHARD HORTON, LIAM DEE, JAMIE DEE, MARIE SATO, RACHAEL FATUADE, RENEE DAVIS, CIARA STEWART, ADAM SHIRET** and **JULIAN LAMY** were the nine winners Shaftesbury nominated for the Jack Petchey Award. The Jack Petchey Foundation gives grants to programmes and projects that benefit young people aged 11-25. The Foundation exists to raise the aspirations of young people, to help them take advantage of opportunities and play a full part in society.

**MARILYN OKORO** (800m) and **SEB RODGER U23** (400m Hurdles) were selected for the GB & NI team for the World Championships in Moscow.

At the British Championships and World Championship Trials **MARILYN OKORO** secured her spot by winning the 800m and **JADE LALLY** won the Discus. Other medalists were Silver from **DAN BRAMBLE** Long Jump and Bronze Medals from **NATHAN FOX** Triple Jump and **CHRIS SCOTT** Discus.

We entered the newly formed UK Youth Development League (U13/U15) – finishing in a respectable 4th position.

The Barnet/SBH composite team were runners-up in the Southern Counties Veteran's League Herts and North Middx Division.

Even more club records were set by – ALLAN SMITH U23 Senior High Jump (2.26m), SABRINA BAKARE U20 400m (52.77), JESSICA HURLEY U15 300m (43.7) and RACHEL CARTER U13 70m Hurdles (11.61).

We won the UK Youth Development League (U17/U20) Southern Premier 1 allowing the team to contest the League Final as Southern Champions.

## SBH PREMIERSHIP CHAMPIONS 2013 and win LEAGUE CLUB OF THE YEAR 2013 TROPHY!

We retained the senior men premiership title and will be representing GB&NI in the European Champion Clubs Cup for Senior's in Portugal May 2014. Also the club won the **JO SMITH TROPHY** which is awarded to the best UK Club on the basis of their league position on a combined basis in both the BAL and UKWAL at the end of the season. The Women's team, in their first season back in the UKWAL Premiership, had tough matches in Edinburgh and Manchester but showed their true strength in the final match at Bromley to finish 3<sup>rd</sup> but this was not quite enough to avoid relegation to National One for 2014 but they will be back up in 2015!

At the World Championships, **WILLEM COERTZEN** competed for South Africa in the Decathlon and finished in 9th place; his point's total of 8343 smashed his personal best by 99 points, also a new Club Record.

At the Scottish Championships, club members won 5 Gold Medals, 2 Silver Medals and 2 Bronze Medals. Performance of the day came from **NICK PERCY** who won the Senior Discus with a New Club Record by an U20 with 55.84m. Our other Gold Medallists were **ALLAN SCOTT** (110m Hurdles), **ALLAN SMITH** U23 (High Jump), **JOHN CARR (**Long Jump), **NONY MORDI** (Triple Jump) and **NICK PERCY** U20 (Discus), Silver Medals from **AMY CAMPBELL** (1500m) and **ANGUS MCINROY** (Discus), Bronze Medals from **CHRIS BENNETT (**Hammer) and **RACHEL HUNTER** U23 (Hammer).

At the South of England U15/U20 Inter County Championships there were Gold Medals from **SABRINA BAKARE** U20 (100m), **GREGORY THOMPSON** U20 (Discus) and **LOUISA JAMES** U20 (Hammer), also Silver Medals from **DEAN OAMEN** U20 (Triple Jump), and Bronze Medals from **MICHAEL CALLEGARI** U20 (800m) and **YASMIN LAKIN** U20 (Triple Jump).

At the South West Inter County Championships **ADAM CARPENTER** U23 won the Pole Vault Gold Medal and **ANDREW ELKINS** U23 won the Hammer Gold Medal.

RICHARD HORTON became World Duathlon Champion 2013 (Under 23).

**ROBBIE LIGHTOWLER** U17 won the British Aquathlon Youth National Championship.

**NICK PERCY** U20 became Triple Scottish Champion – he won the Shot Put 6kg, Discus 1.75kg and Hammer 6kg.

At the South of England U15/U17 Championships, CALLUM SCUTT won the Bronze Medal (Long Jump).

At the England Athletics U15 & U17 Championships **MICHAEL CALLEGARI** U20 ran away with Under 20 Gold Medal in the 3000m. The 4 x 100m Relay team of **OJE ETOMI** U20, **CHIMDI KEMA** U17, **JORDAN ARCHER** U17, **BAMI FALANA** U20 took the Under 20 Bronze Medal.

KOJO KYEREME V35 won the Surrey 10,000m Championships.

At the Youth Development League National Under 17 and 20 Final the Men won their section convincingly. Overall, the combined match the club came 3<sup>rd</sup>. As winners of the men's competition, SBH will be representing Great Britain & NI in the European Champion Clubs Cup for Juniors in 2014 in Spain.

At the Eastern Young Athletes League Plate Final, the Barnet/SBH composite team finished in 6th place.

At the Southern Counties Veterans League Final, the Barnet/SBH composite Women's team, finished in 6th place.

At British Masters Championships we had two Double Gold Medal winning performances, firstly from **NENGI OSSAI** V35 who won the 100m and 200m and secondly **GREG DUNSON** V45 won the 110m Hurdles and the 400m Hurdles. **LISA WEBB** V45 won the Silver Medal in the 1500m and also the Bronze Medal in the 400m.

SOPHIA PARVIZI-WAYNE U17 won the 3000m Gold Medal in the UK Schools Games.

At the Hertfordshire and Middlesex Young Athletes Road Relay we had over 50 Young Athletes competing with 6 wins plus 5 of our runners running the fastest leg of their race.

WILLIAM PRIOR U13 set a new Javelin Club Record throw of 37.95m.

At the European Champions Clubs Cup for Juniors held in Brno, Czech Republic, we claimed a creditable 2nd place, in a very close finish.

ALLAN SMITH and NICK PERCY have been selected for Scotland for the 2014 Commonwealth Games.

At the Southern Young Athletes Road Relays there were Gold Medals for the U13 Boys, Silver Medals for the U17 Men and Bronze Medals for the U17 Women. Also **JAMIE HARPER** U13 and **SOPHIA PARVIZI-WAYNE** U17 had the fastest times in their races.

There was a good all round performance from our team at the Southern Senior Women's Road Relays including the fastest time of the day from **BETH POTTER**.

On a sadder note we need to report that **ROBERT POPE** and **ROGER DUNKLEY** passed away during the year.

Finally congratulations to all our many members who contributed to our team successes. Apologies if you have not been mentioned by name but I can assure you that our success during the last year has been due to the efforts of everyone. Good luck to you all in 2014.
