# Bristow retains title

ANDY BRISTOW comfortably defended his Southern title with an accomplished piece of front running at Havant on January 12 writes **Steve Smythe**. However, perhaps the real story was the performance of runner-up John Downes who matched last year's second place, despite suffering from influenza, and finished in a state of collapse.

As so often in recent months the weather made it difficult for the runners. This time bright sunshine made visibility difficult around the sticky muddy course!

Bristow made the break towards the end of the first lap and he quickly opened up a gap. "It wasn't a conscious effort," said Bristow, "It was just a case of hitting a rhythm and keeping it going. It was tough underfoot, a bit of a slog, and I would have preferred it had it been flatter."

By halfway the margin was up to 18 seconds with Barry Royden, Julian Gentry and John Sherban sharing second place, six seconds clear of Richard Partridge. A further eight seconds back was Downes, working hard alone but seeming to have little chance of a medal. Clearly the team race was going to be a North London battle with both Shaftesbury and Highgate providing seven of the top 40.

By the end of the second lap the leaders' positions had not changed but Partridge and Downes had reduced the gap on the chasing trio with Bristow's margin now more than 100 metres.

Bristow maintained most of that lead on his three mile lap of honour but there was plenty of action behind him. Partridge caught Sherban, and a tiring Royden and Gentry during the seventh mile and Downes shortly afterwards also regained contact.

On the far side of the course, first Partridge and then Sherban made efforts and both Royden and Gentry fell away in the eighth mile. Sherban, who has been showing good form in Scotland this winter, broke the game Partridge and had only Downes for company in the battle for second as they started the final mile. Up the last hill Downes, who had been as low as ninth, made his move and his strength proved too much for Sherban. His powerful finish took over 11 seconds off Bristow in the final mile but the winning margin was still 16 seconds, two less than in 1990.

While Bristow looked relaxed as he crossed the line, the effort of nine muddy miles, while feeling unwell, clearly told on Downes' legs which gave way on him as he reached the finish. Sherban, seventh and leading

'southerner' in last year's National, held on for third and made his journey from his new Edinburgh home worthwhile by leading Shaftesbury to team victory. Packing solidly and effectively, poor Kirk Dumpleton finished 34th and didn't even make their scoring six who were all home by 28th in the 1000 strong field.

Highgate also packed well (six in 33) and, though scoring 49 less than last year's winners Brighton, they had to be content with second place, as in 1990.

Bristow is also shaping up well for the trials/UK Championships and is confident of making the team for Antwerp where he was Britain's third scorer in last year's race in Aix-les-Bains.

Also likely to be lining up in Belgium but as part of the Irish team is Downes. "The training's been going really well" said the London Irish athlete. "I went down with the flu on Wednesday but thought I'd run to help the club. I felt tired but kept plugging away and managed to kick away up that final hill. I'd been hopeful before I was unwell that I'd be in that position with Bristow as I'm sure I could have beaten him. At the finish I guess my legs were weak from the flu."

The Junior race provided the day's classiest line-up. Half of Britain's six man team from France, Jon Gascoyne, Malcolm Campbell and Kevin Toher were in the field along with AAA 3000m champion Rob Kettle, the first two from last year's Youths' race Spencer Barden and Stuart Poore. Also expected to challenge were the Essex, Kent and Sussex champions respectively Keith Cullen, Dave Robertson and Steve Harris.

A large pack disputed most of the first lap before the pace began to tell on all but Gascoyne, Cullen and Campbell. The trio were still together as they hit the final mile. Campbell made a big move up the last hill which effectively ended the challenge of Cullen though his Essex rival still looked comfortable. Gascoyne made his decisive effort on the downhill stretch 800m out and he quickly opened up a gap which he was able to hold to the finish. His eventual winning margin was given as just a second although it appeared fairly comfortable. There was a much smaller one second gap between second and third! Cullen rallied in the last 400m to overhaul Campbell who had outkicked him to win the AAA Junior 5000m though the smaller Campbell never gave up and finished less than a metre down.

Toher moved through to sixth with a strong final lap and had the added bonus of leading Newquay and Par to

their first ever Southern title.

If 1990 was the year of the footballing Gazza then 1991 has not started too badly for the more modest athletic version from Harlow.

He was clearly pleased to gain revenge on Cullen who had outkicked him in the Inter-Area at Margate last month and looks on course for a high placing at Antwerp.

"The training's been going well recently and when Malcolm kicked up the hill I tucked in and felt strong," said Gascoyne.


Terry Mackin was a surprise winner of the Youths race. Fifty fourth in last year's event he was delighted to turn the tables on

Southend's Richard Edwards who had outkicked him in the North of the Thames race. The 17 year-old sealed his win with a powerful drive down the final hill. Edwards made a brave effort which closed the gap to two seconds in the finishing straight but victory went to the Old Gaytonian, with team honours again going to Shaftesbury.

Victory in the Boys race went to 15 year-old Judd schoolboy Adrian Whitwam. The Tonbridge runner who had won his Kent County race with a ferocious start was content to wait until the final hill before breaking up the pack which also contained Dean McMullin, Cairn Stone and Craig Rogers. Only 23rd last year he stretched the margin to five seconds over McMullin by the finish.

Aldershot were winning team but Shaftesbury, only 16th here, had done enough in the other races to win the Beadle Cup for the overall most successful club. That trophy was presented by Gordon Pirie who won 16 Southern cross country titles and who has happily left hospital after collapsing at Christmas.


