#### **Age Group Changes Webinars**

Ahead of the <u>age group changes</u> coming into effect next April, England Athletics is hosting a series of online drop-in sessions over the coming months, to allow those within the sport to get any remaining questions answered, or queries clarified. ## **Successful Funetics Multi-Event Challenge Pilot**

England Athletics recently held one of the pilot events for an exciting new competition format, funetics multi-challenge, which aims to encourage more regular, age-appropriate opportunities for primary school aged children to compete in athletics. More than 130 children participated in the competition, hosted by Athletics Norfolk and held at the University of East Anglia, with 14 clubs and associations represented. Initial feedback from athletes and parents was that the new format worked well and that there is increasing demand for fun competition from primary aged children, many of whom are already competing regularly in other sports. ## Talent Event Leads (TEL)

All of the TELs are in the process of confirming dates, times, venues, deliverers and content for the pre-YTP regional workshops and the National Masterclasses. They are also in the process of organising dates for webinars and virtual community of practice sessions.

Once confirmed the pre-YTP workshops will be set up on athletics hub for people to book. Athletes will be £10 and coaches will be free. The focus will be talented U15-U17 athletes and their coaches who are likely to progress onto the talent pathway in the next few years.

# Anti-Doping

## **2025** Prohibited List: Summary of Changes



The World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) has recently released the <u>2025 Prohibited List</u> (the List) which details the substances and methods that are banned within sport. Broken down into several categories, the list identifies which substances and methods are prohibited at all times, in-competition only, and within specific sports.

Following an extensive consultation period by WADA, the 2025 List was published on 25 September 2024. This gives athletes and support personnel sufficient time to make themselves aware of the changes, review any medications they use, and apply for a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if required before the updated list comes into effect on 1 January 2025.
