# **Women's Throws Coach Community**

We are delighted to share that the Women's Throws Coach Group, supported by the <u>Female Coaching Network</u>, has now launched. ### **Seated Throws Development Day**

As part of this we have organised a development day which is open to new and existing coaches to sign up to learn more about Seated Throws (10am-5pm). ## **Local Throws Coach Development**

On Sunday 14th September Katie Lambert facilitated a development day for club throws coaches from the West Midlands. The day included a SWOT analysis and a discussion around the key areas the coaches and clubs needed support. We are organising follow-up practical days that meet the needs of the group.

On Saturday 18th October Garry Power facilitated a throws practical day for coaches from the South East. We had 8 coaches attend and all left with a better understanding of the technical excellence frameworks, planning and physical preparation of club throwers. We plan on following this up with another session in November for London based club throws coaches.

On Saturday 25th October Rob Earle and Simon Mennell facilitated a development day for the club coaches in the east region. 12 coaches attended. May of the coaches supported by this programme have built the confidence to start accessing the regional coach and athlete training days organised. Hopefully they will start progressing club throwers onto the talent pathway in the years to come.

# **2025 Prohibited List: Summary of Changes**



The World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) has recently released the <u>2025 Prohibited List</u> (the List) which details the substances and methods that are banned within sport. Broken down into several categories, the list identifies which substances and methods are prohibited at all times, incompetition only, and within specific sports.

Following an extensive consultation period by WADA, the 2025 List was published on 25 September 2024. This gives athletes and support personnel sufficient time to make themselves aware of the changes, review any medications they use, and apply for a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if required before the updated list comes into effect on 1 January 2025.
