- 2). Minutes of the AGM held on 26th November 2024 were agreed:

- 4). Annual Report:

The Annual Report was presented by the Philip Cunningham (General Secretary) who highlighted five members that competed at the World Championship. He also noted the numerous individual and team winners in T&F (indoor and outdoor), Cross Country, Road Running and Relays events at County, Area and National levels with the club having success across all age groups. Philip thanked Alan Weller for his weekly newsletters upon which the Annual Report was based.

5). Annual Accounts:

The Annual Accounts were presented by the Geoff Morphitis (Treasurer). He noted that there were some one-off contributions in last years accounts (prior year adjustments) and that this mostly accounted for a drop in income of circa £17K. Expenditure items have gone up generally and were circa £11k higher this year. Overall the club made a profit of around £3K.

A request was made for the reference to St John's Ambulance to be removed as we no longer use them. A query over the Aurther Kendall Fund was raised and it was agreed to further discuss this at the next Council meeting.

John Kelly (Club Chairman) thanked Clyde Gordon for his help in putting together the accounts. He also gave a special thanks to Geoff Morphitis who has been the Club Treasurer for the last 36 years!

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The acceptance of the club accounts were proposed by Richard Bober and Seconded by Gerald Alterman and approved.

6). Election of Officers:

The proposed list of Officers (slightly amended from the version sent out in the weekly newsletter following the withdrawal from some positions and consultation on other posts) was accepted by the meeting with the modification that the Coaches Secretary would now be Tom Butler.

John Kelly stressed the need to fill three important vacant roles including Treasurer, Meetings Manager and Clerk to the Council and asked for help to fill these critical jobs.

7). Election of Vice Presidents:

The list of Vice Presidents was accepted.

8). Election of Life Members:

There was no change to the list of Life Members, and therefore no vote was taken.

9). Subscriptions:

The proposal to raise the annual subscription to £90 was accepted after being proposed by Gerald Alterman and Seconded by Collete Hurley (Club President).
