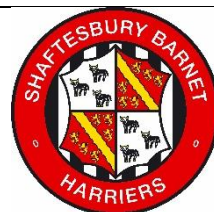

Rebecca Wheeler-Henry U23 also won the Bronze Medal in the High jump.

At the Middlesex Schools Cross Country Championships Dennys Pascal won the Gold Medal in the Minor Boys and Lewis Ward won the Silver Medal. In the Intermediate Girls Posie Shaw won the Bronze Medal and in the Senior Boys Tommy Narvaez-White also won the Bronze Medal.

At the Hertfordshire Schools Cross Country Championships Aimee Porter won the Junior Girls Gold Medal.

At the Hertfordshire and Middlesex Cross Country Championships Gianleo Stubbs U20 won the Gold Medal and Thomas Butler SM won the Bronze Medal in the Herts Champs and Ben Kaspar U13 won the Gold Medal and Dennys Pascal U13 won the Silver Medal in the Middlesex with SBH being the team. At the UK Indoor Championships John Otugade won the Silver Medal in the 60m, Krishawn Aiken won the Bronze Medal in the 200m, Lina Nielsen won the Silver Medal in the 400m with Emily Newnham U23 finishing 4th and further fourth places from Craig Moncur U23 and Jessica Hunter in

the 60m hurdles. Kimani Jack U23 won the Silver Medal in the High Jump and Scott Lincoln (HCA) won the Gold Medal in the Shot 7.26kg.

At the British Masters Indoor Championships Claire Spurway V45 Gold Medal in the 200m, the Silver Medal in the 60m and the Bronze Medal in the 400m, Sean Sutherland V50 won the Silver Medal in the 200m and Bronze in the High Jump, Lisa Webb V55 won the Bronze Medal in the 800m, Gary Smith V50 (EMAC 2nd Claim) won the Gold Medal in 60m hurdles and Rosalind Zeffertt V60 won the Gold Medal in the Pole Vault.
