January Highlights

Shot Put

- Harry Beard (Greg Beard) indoor PB of 16.72m whilst representing England in the Reykjavik international Games
- Sophie McKinna (Greg Beard) is back in action after some time away from the sport and threw 16.87m also at the Reykjavik international Games
- Serena Vincent (Mike Winch & Andrew Vincent) started her indoor season off in Portugal throwing 17.16m for third at the competition.
- Piers Cameron (Kyle Stringer) putted a indoor PB of 19.07m and is currently ranked 10th in the NCAA.
- Amy Thompson (F41) (Mark Edwards) indoor PB of 8.23m to win the England Athletics Indoor Para Nationals
- Anna Nicholson (F35) (Richard Kaufman) putted her best ever season opener and indoor PB of 9.24m to come 2nd at the England Athletics Indoor Para Nationals
- Taz Nichol (F57) (Alison O'Riordan) putted his best ever season opener of 10.93m.

Reykjavik International Games

AA small team of athletes represented England at the Reykjavík Games this weekend; strong performances from all athletes resulted in medals and indoor PBs. Lloyd Cowan Bursary

Lloyd Cowan Bursary has launched the Sophie Hahn Para Athlete Fund, a new initiative that champions para-athletes and expands access to the sport. The fund marks the fifth anniversary of Lloyd Cowan MBE's death and celebrates a legacy rooted in belief, opportunity and community. The Fund will open for applications on Friday 16th January 2026 and close on Monday 16th February. Sport England

The government is proposing to remove Sport England as a statutory consultee on planning applications. This change could have serious consequences for the protection of playing fields (including seasonal grass running tracks on school sites) and community sports facilities (including track & field facilities) – the very spaces that make our sport accessible to everyone. (Both EA and UKA have formally opposed the Government's proposals). The Sport & Recreation Alliance has launched a petition urging the government to keep Sport England's vital role in the planning process. Age Group Implement Weights for Para Throws

We have proposed recommended implement weights for U12, U14, U16, and U18 para throwers across all throwing events and classifications, for use by competition organisers. The Commonwealth Games Federation have announced the Para Athletics Qualification System will consist of two methods of qualification for the 2026 Glasgow Commonwealth Games. Direct Qualification – World Para Athletics Commonwealth Rankings (ranking period is between 1 January 2025 to 23:59 on 31 March 2026). Bipartite Invitation. England Athletics will recommend to Commonwealth Games England that it accepts each invitation allocated to an English athlete.

2026 Prohibited List: Summary of Changes

The World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) has recently released the [2026 Prohibited List](#) (the List) which details the substances and methods that are banned within sport. Broken down into several categories, the list identifies which substances and methods are prohibited at all times, in-competition only, and within specific sports.
